

MAMMOTT juice boxes

Note: These are made ONLY to fit Costco's Kirkland juice boxes.



1. PREFERRED METHOD:

Print page 2 (Mammott labels) onto full-sheet sticker paper. (Print however many copies of Page 2 that you need for your juice boxes.) First, you'll need to remove the straws that are glued to the boxes. Next, cut out each label, remove backing, and wrap around juice box. It's best to first line up his face onto the front of the box, then wrap the sides.) You can choose to re-attach the straws to the back with hot glue.

ALTERNATIVE METHOD:

Print onto standard copy paper and attach with a glue stick or double-sided tape. (May not adhere as well as the sticker paper, though, since the juice boxes are smooth and waxy-feeling.)

2. Print page 3 (Mammott feet) onto cardstock. (110 lbs. cardstock is ideal for most home printers.) Cut out each pair of feet and attach with hot glue or glue stick. You can either attach on the underside of the juice box, or like I have done - I folded the top of the foot up and attached on the bottom front of the juice box.
